

Drury Community Committee Meeting minutes

Minutes of last meeting: Approved by Ron Bagrie, seconded by Gary McCraith.

Matters arising from last meeting: nil

1. Structure of committee and meetings: subgroups to cover different topics to work separately with discussions on the internet and in small groups. Will come back to main meeting to report. Looking at reforming a separate business group.
2. Consideration of the value of a community group in Drury: includes an interface with the council to inform and give feedback.
3. Data base to be created for both community committee, business group. Association with civil defence data base through Ron Bagrie. All attendees are asked to reach out to their own contacts to include in data base for information sharing and participation in meetings.
4. Creation of subgroups within Drury community committee: Leigh Ingle has offered to create an outline of what these could be called and what they would cover. To come back to Barry for further discussion. Possible subgroups could be: business, leisure, safety and security, events (eg ANZAC), transport, community organisations, development and housing.
5. Who's who in Drury: As this is now out-of-date, Gary McCraith has offered to update it.
6. Railway station in Drury: Andy Baker (Franklin Local Board) has informed us that this will not occur until the electrification comes through. There will be another opportunity to put in a submission regarding this soon.
7. ANZAC parade: We need a willing volunteer to take over the job of organising the Drury parade. Liz Palmer, who has organised this in the past, will do up a template of what is involved. The things that need to be done soon are: find a guest speaker, and book a pipe band.
8. Complaints to council: this discussion was mostly focused around liquor licencing. This can be done by going to <http://www.public-notices.co.nz/> , put in the area of interest and objections can be made. David Robson is going to put a link on the Drury website to notifications of liquor licencing in Drury.
9. www.shapeauckland.co.nz: Discusses the annual budget for 2016/17 for Auckland. This will influence rates, transport, civil defence and other factors. Please have a look before 24 March to give feedback. Note that at this website you can have your say on many things.

Plan for next meeting: Finalise committee subgroups, assign people to these groups.
